

Girls' Ball Teams Clash At Stadium Tomorrow

The Peoria Red Wings will meet the Ft. Wayne Daisies in the first girls' baseball game of a two-game series tomorrow at Red Bird Stadium at 8:30 p. m. It promises to be one of Columbus' biggest sports events of the year.

The two teams are winding up an exhibition series that has taken them through three Alabama cities, two in North Carolina and one city in Virginia. They will arrive in Columbus at noon tomorrow.

Advance weather reports state the weather will be clear and bright for both events. The Sunday game will start at 2 p. m.
