A DESPERATE ACT.

A Well-to-Do Gérman Tries to Take His Life By Disemboweling Himself.

George Leslein, a German 68 years of age, living in a two-story brick house at 718 South Third street, attempted suicide yeserday by disemboweling himself. Leslein has been an invalid for ten years, being disabled by a rupture. Shortly before noon his wife went downstairs leaving him in bed. When she returned he lay in a pool of blood in a small room adjoining. In his hand he grasped a razor with which he grasped a razor with which he had cut a semi-circular gash 8 inohes in length in the lower part of the abdomen. The intestines, which had also been cut, protruded. Drs. Frank Warner and G. W. Murrey sewed up the wounds. Last night Leslein was still alive, with scarcely any hopes for his recovery. He repented and called for his minister, Rev. Richard Herbst, to whom he expressed regret for what he had done. Recently he has been despondent, and several times threatened to take his life. Leslein is comfortably fixed in this world's goods and only temporary insanity, caused by his long illness, could have forced him to so rash an act. He has two grown sons and three daughters.




