LANCASTER, Ohio - A 16-year-old Lancaster girl was killed in a one-car accident Tuesday night in Bloom Township in Fairfield County.

Maria D. Taylor died when she lost control of her car on Sitterly Road about 9:10 p.m., Fairfield County Sheriff Gary DeMastry said.

Taylor 's car went off the road, slid into a culvert and went airborne twice before hitting a utility pole, DeMastry said.

Taylor was a member of the Bloom Carroll High School Chamber Singers and the Christian Horse Club.

Visitation will be from 2 to 4 and 6 to 8 p.m. Friday at the Dwayne R. Spence Funeral Home in Canal Winchester. A funeral will be at 10:30 a.m. Saturday in Lithopolis United Methodist Church in Lithopolis, Ohio.
