This is the link for accessing Penny's Family Tree, "Simms, Nichols and allied Families." The Leslein Family tree is located withing this very large tree of over 9,000 members.

Once one uses the above link to visit Ancestry.com - it will be required to log in.

If no account has been established, it is easy to have a "free" account, by just signing up with an email address and whatever password one desires.

Then once logged in - the family tree will appear.

However, when the family tree appears, the left side starts with any particular person or ancestor. To access one's own personal family line - it will require that a search for a name is done.

If one taps/clicks on the very right of the TOP BAR, that says "find in tree," which brings up the following window:



Type in the name of your parent, (if mother – use maiden name). Then the parent's name is on the far left of the entire tree.

** Special Note - As the Leslein Family has grown in leaps & bounds after Penny's research of the ancestors... it is very likely a particular family has not been updated.

The "Ancestors" are all prior to many generations

"Generation 1" is Michael Leslein's Great-Grandparents and also Louise Schimpf Leslein's Great-Grandparents

Generation 2" is Michael Leslein's Grandparents and also Louise Schimpf Leslein's Grandparents

"Generation 3," is MICHAEL LESLIEN (1882-1960)

"Generation 4" consists of ALL of Michael & Louise's children

"Generation 5" consists of ALL of Michael & Louise's grandchildren

"Generation 6" consists of the great-grandchildren (which is definitely not updated)

Apologies to the loved ones, who have sadly passed & not noted.
